



MUSTAFA MURAT ŞEKER
ASELSAN VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Mustafa Murat ŞEKER was born in 1968 in Kayseri. He graduated from Middle East Technical University, Electrical and Electronic Engineering Department in 1992 and continued his graduate level studies in the same department between 1992-1994.

He has been working at Undersecretariat for Defence Industries since 1992. He took charge in several projects as Assistant Specialist and Specialist between the years 1992-2000. He worked as the Project Manager responsible for important projects about Helicopter and Aircraft Modernization, C4I, Radar, Electronic Warfare and Satellites starting from year 2000. At this position, he also managed the GÖKTÜRK project, which is the first reconnaissance and surveillance satellite of Turkey.

In 2011 he was appointed as the Head of Naval Platforms Department, where major and complicated projects like New Type Submarine, National Corvette (MILGEM), Landing Platform Dock (LPD) and TF-2000 were executed under his supervision.

In 2014 he has been appointed as the Head of Electronic Warfare and Radar Systems Department and during his duty, he coordinated the management of more than fifty radar and electronic warfare projects including the Early Warning Radar and Stand-off Jammer Projects.

Mustafa Murat ŞEKER was appointed as the Deputy Undersecretary responsible for all the system projects executed by the Undersecretariat for Defence Industries in 2015 and is still carrying this duty.

He was a Member of Board of Auditors of MIKES in 2010 and 2011, Member of Board of Auditors of HEAŞ in 2012.

Mustafa Murat ŞEKER, who was elected as a Member of Board of Directors with the resolution of Board of Directors on 23 May 2013, has served as the Chairman of the Board in between March 2015 – March 2017. He was elected as the Vice Chairman of ASELSAN with the resolution of Board of Directors on 02 April 2017.
