He was appointed as the Deputy Director in 2014 for TÜBİTAK Marmara Research Center (MRC) Material Institute. Shortly after this appointment, he became the Vice President of MRC responsible for Business Development and Industrialization. He has focused on coordinating industry centric technology development and transfer as well as coordinating critical projects. He served as Turkish delegate to NMBP (Nanotechnologies, Advanced Materials, Biotechnology and Advanced Manufacturing and Processing) program committee Horizon 2020.

At the beginning of 2018 he was appointed as ASELSAN Transportation, Security, Energy, Automation and Healthcare Systems (UGES) Business Sector CEO and ASELSAN Vice President.
