Mustafa Murat ŞEKER was born in Kayseri in 1968. He graduated from the Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering at METU in 1992, and started his career at the Undersecretariat of Defense Industries the same year.

After working as Assistant Specialist and Specialist in projects such as MEBS, Radar, Electronic Warfare, Satellite Communication, Helicopter and Aircraft Modernization, he was appointed as Project Manager to the Radar and Satellite Projects group in 2002. With this title, he managed the GÖKTÜRK project, Turkey's first reconnaissance and surveillance satellite.

In 2011, he was appointed as the Head of the Department of Naval Vehicles and carried out extensive and large projects such as MİLGEM and New Type Submarine. He was appointed as the Head of Electronic Warfare and Radar Systems Department in 2014, and coordinated the management of more than fifty projects, including the Early Warning Radar and Stand-off Jammer projects.

He was appointed as the Deputy Undersecretary in 2015 and still serves as the Vice President of Defense Industry responsible for Electronic Warfare and Radar, MEBS, Cyber Security and Informatics, and Land Vehicles.

He served as Member of the Board of Auditors at MİKES and HEAŞ between 2010-2013, Chairman and Member of the Board of Directors of ASELSAN A.Ş. between 2013-2020, and Chairman of the Board of Directors of HAVELSAN A.Ş. in 2020.

Mustafa Murat ŞEKER, who is still a Member of the Board of Directors of the Turkish Accelerator and Radiation Laboratory (TARLA) and Vice Chairman of Ankara Aerospace Industry Zone, was elected as a Member of the Board of Directors of ASELSAN A.Ş. at the Ordinary General Assembly Meeting held on June 29, 2021.
